Writing:
 This term, within their fiction work, children will be examining and using features found within playscripts. The non-fiction unit will explore the purpose and strategies of writing instructional texts. Children will also learn about the features and implementation of various grammatical features.

Computing:
 Children will develop their programming skills and work using Scratch coding to create animations and basic games.

Art:
 Art from nature is the theme that will underpin the children's art lessons this term. They will experiment in different mediums and have a chance to develop painting and sculpting skills. There will be a Roman theme across this unit to link with work in history.

PE:
 This half-term, children will spend time learning techniques and ball skills. These lessons will also be complemented by lessons in general fitness.

Modern Foreign Languages:
 French lessons will be built around language used in describing clothing. Children will also develop their language detective skills.

Reading:
 Reading will be supported both through: the school-wide strategy, centring on a phonics-led approach and through the class-based approach. This includes regular child-teacher reading and incorporates the Accelerated Reader programme.



PSHCE:
 The unit of work this term is focussed on celebrating difference. The children will examine why it is a positive thing that each of us is unique and will aim to challenge stereotypes and snap judgements.

RE:
 Children will be learning about Christian beliefs around the Holy Trinity. They will be applying their learning to understand why this plays such an important role in the day to day lives of Christian people.

Core Value:
 This term there will be a focus on Good Choices. This will be emphasised, both in terms of learning attitudes and in non-academic situations.

Mathematics:
 Children will continue their learning in addition and subtraction, before moving onto the operations of multiplication and division. Towards the end of the term, they will begin to think about how to apply their learning and use different approaches to this. Children will also continue their multiplication tables and fluency facts learning.

History:
 The learning this term is centred around the Romans' invasion and occupation of Britain. Children will explore the invasion attempts and how the Romans lived in Britain and the legacy they left behind.

Music:
 This term, the children will be focussing on rhythm and composition. They will use Glockenspiels to learn and practise various pieces, including an independent composition.

Science:
 Learning covers understanding around light. Children will have the opportunity to use and develop their reasoning, investigating and recording skills. They will also be involved in planning, carrying out and drawing conclusions from investigations.

Extra Curricular Learning:
 This half-term St Andrew's will visit the Yeovil pantomime. There will also be access to after school clubs, including sports, curriculum based activities and Forest School.
