Art & Design:

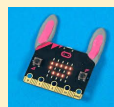
We shall be looking at 'design for purpose', working as a team to design posters, fliers and scenery in preparation for the end of year production.

Computing:

During this half term, the children will be using the skills learnt last term to design and make their own product using micro:bit technology.

PSHCE - Changing Me:

In this unit, we shall learn about our body-image and how babies are conceived, develop and born. We shall also teach how relationships change in puberty and the changes that will happen to their bodies.

Mathematics:

This term we shall cover a range of maths areas. Year 6 will be improving final arithmetic skills while tackling tricky problem-solving challenges. Year 5 will be returning to place value and the four operations to be in a strong position for Year 6 by the end of the year.

History:

In our lessons this term, we shall continue our study of Ancient Greek culture and the Olympics. The children started this learning journey in the spring term and are enthusiastic to learn more about the legacy from this period of history.
